#### **Race to the Top Resolution:**

We the board of Prestige Academy understanding the importance of Race to the Top and student achievement and recognizing that we signed the memorandum of understanding fully support the goals and ambitions of the program. However, after fully reviewing the LEA work plan and budget have come to the conclusion that the Race to the Top program is not fully funded as of today. We estimate our funding needs over the four year program to be \$481,000. At the recommendation of our Finance Committee, we the Board of Prestige Academy instruct Don Mell, Board Chair, and Jack Perry, Executive Director to withdraw the school from the program if a minimum 90% of \$481,000 is not provided through State and Federal Funding. Van Hampton made a motion at 7:58p.m. and second by B. Ritterbeck to accept the resolution. The motion was approved by all.
